“The Dutchman” – An old term for a very useful item that was just reborn recently for a Red-Hed customer. The device is simple enough: A filler flange! With an angle! Not a sales angle! But a real sloping face to be more precise! This is used when the men in the field’s level is off and you can no longer line up in plane to each other, the two pieces of pipe! The *Dutchman* has an angled face to match the offset and bring things back in line with one another! The customer must specify the angle! If they have problems with the geometry, call Bruce and he’ll tell you what you need to get, in the way of information and he’ll even do the math for you!

“Redi-daptor” – Sounds like something from Jurassic Park, but its not! This new toy from the elves at Red-Hed allows the user to switch easily from: DIN, JIS or ISO bolt patterns to the US Standard AWWA bolt pattern! Non-domestic pumps and valves will often have the German DIN, the Japanese JIS or a European metric bolt pattern! The *Redi-daptor* is a unit similar to the Space Saver Flange that makes this change to AWWA in a very short distance and in a single piece!

Lead Flange Adaptors – The list keeps growing! We already have a huge assortment of adaptors and we have added several new ones to this list in July! These are not on your price list or in the catalog as they are matched to the component! If you are able, please send us in what you are trying to adapt to. This can be either the nut or the valve itself! Most likely, we make one! If not, we most likely will now!
